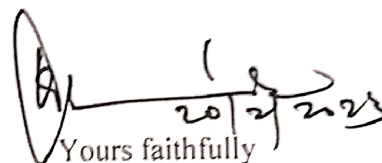

Theme of the Seminar:-

Biodiversity and ecosystem services are central to sustaining life on Earth and play an important role in achieving sustainable development in its three dimensions- Economic, Social and Environmental. The present world, a product of millions of years of evolution is passing through the most critical changes in geological history causing grave and irreparable damage to the earth. The current global crisis is primarily attributed to the increase of greenhouse gases especially CO₂ in our atmosphere, caused by human activities particularly through burning of fossil fuels, deforestation and agriculture.

Biodiversity, the totality of species, genes and ecosystems underpins all ecosystem goods and services responsible for providing food and water, buffering the impacts of climate change, controlling the outbreak of diseases and supporting nutrient cycling. Every biodiversity element has an intrinsic value, irrespective of human knowledge on its utility, needs and interests. Although estimated numbers of species around the world are about 8.7 million, currently about 2.0 million were on record. Worldwide destruction of the natural environment has led to a tremendous loss of biological diversity over the past few decades. Climate change has led to phenological shifts in flowering plants and insect pollinators, causing mismatches between plant and pollinator populations that lead to the extinctions of both the plant and the pollinator.

The strategies for conserving species in the context of climate change should primarily focus on human attitude towards biodiversity and need a paradigm shift in people's perspective on environmental resources. To achieve effective conservation, a wide range of stakeholders-government, private sector, non-governmental organisations (NGOs), politicians, general public, communities and media have to integrate to create changes in values, attitudes, knowledge, policy, procedures and behaviours towards environment.

My presentation for this seminar focuses on the dynamics of biodiversity conservation from global to local level and our team contribution in conservation activity.



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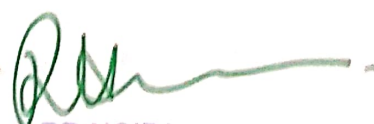
**OBSERVATIONS ON THREE YEAR OLD MIYAWAKI PLANTATION OF
SRI KRISHNADEVARAYA UNIVERSITY, ANANTHAPURAMU**

Miyawaki Afforestation method developed by Akira Miyawaki, a Japanese environmentalist is aimed to restore native forests from seeds of native trees on much degraded soils which were barren, deforested and without humus. The Miyawaki method of reconstitution of 'indigenous forests by indigenous trees' produces a rich, dense and efficient protective pioneer forest in 20-30 years, which in natural conditions may take 300 years. Key steps in Miyawaki Afforestation are: digging the soil in usually one acre area for about 2 feet and lifted out the site and added with native fresh soil to fill the pits; adding and spread out coco-peat, vermicomposting, sprayed with cow urine and thoroughly mix; selected native species, collected from different sources were planted at a distance of 0.5-1m and whole be covered with hay and connected with drip irrigation from a tube-well. S.K. University Miyawaki Afforestation Plot, sponsored and supported by Andhra Pradesh Greening and Beautification Corporation, Vijayawada is of 4000 m² (≈1 acre) area and started on November 16, 2019. Currently, the plantation is diversified with 157 native species-128 trees, 22 shrubs, 4 climbers; 3 Cycads with natural herbaceous ground cover.
